



Immunization Policy at DYF Programs

Campers attending DYF programs are required to have current immunizations based on California law, the standards set by the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the recommendation of the Center for Disease Control. Due to the nature of camp and the communal living in which it takes place, public health and safety is of utmost importance at DYF programs.

Vaccination records will be requested in pre-camp paperwork, and those with a valid exception will be asked to complete a waiver.

Per California law, policy exceptions exist for those who have a physician-documented, medical reason for being unable to receive a particular vaccination.
