



## **Parent Phone Call Timeline: DYF Programs**

- Calls to be completed immediately following incident:
  - Injuries that require care that cannot be conducted at camp.
    - Possible fractures/breaks, lacerations/cuts, x-rays, stitches, etc.
- Calls to be completed within 5 hours of incident:
  - Ill with ketones
    - If a camper is vomiting or feeling ill AND has ketones, a parent will be notified within 5 hours.
    - Those who need a site change and injection, but feel fine otherwise, will not have a parent notified.
- Calls to be completed within 24 hours of incident:
  - Camper begins taking antibiotics.
    - Parents will not be notified for routine use of ibuprofen, Tylenol, bendryl, etc.
  - Camper spends the night in the medical building
    - Those who rest for a few hours will not have a parent notified. Rest could be invoked by headache, menstrual cramps, mild stomach ache, etc.
  - Camper violates a camp rule that puts them in jeopardy of being sent home and/or a behavior contract is written.
